According to the latest information from the African-based Carry the Future Federation (01.04.2015), the number of the needy in the European crisis has risen to 507 million and is still rising. Europe is in a process of alienation. People have forgotten how to relate to each other. How to share. How to foster a sense of community. The role of aid workers has changed. GO TO EUROPE - SHOW TO SHARE

Europe is ruled by the ego. People strive for power and success, and have forgotten such values as humility, compassion and generosity. This is a drastic departure from the principles of altruism, upon which the European Union was founded. European Union? Hardly.

GO TO EUROPE - HELP TO LOVE

Europe is now a very lonely place. A very, very lonely place. The continent might be linked economically but it nonetheless suffers from a sad lack of interpersonal relationships. Social aspirations and superficial aesthetics have taken the place of intimacy, family, community. Workers are at the mercy of corporations. Producers exploit consumers. Where, we ask, is the love? It's a dog-eat-dog world in Europe. The situation is now desperate.

By turning their backs, closing borders and closing hearts, the European Union has made a bad situation considerably worse. The time has come for action. For RESCEU. Volunteers from all over Africa, the Middle East and the Balkans are, at this very moment, prevented from entering the EU. RESCEU demands that Europe fling open its borders and embrace this new, visionary community. To swallow its pride and accept the help on offer.
